TIVERTON TOWN YOUTH DEVELOPMENT 2011 TOURNAMENT RULES

TEAMS

1. Teams will consist of 8 (eight) players maximum, one of whom shall be the goalkeeper. Two of the players shall be substitutes.
2. All players must be registered in the correct age group.
3. Team list to be nominated on the registration form and submitted to be checked by a responsible person prior to the Tournament. **Managers must carry proof of players' ages to save any arguments on the day.** The organising committee decision is final. Any team playing a player in the wrong age group will be disqualified and will forfeit their entrance money.
4. U8s, U9s, U10s & U11s ALL MINI SOCCER RULES

ALL OTHER AGE GROUPS (U12s & U13s BOYS, U13s GIRLS & U14 Boys)

1. Only the goalkeeper is allowed inside the goal area. If he/she leaves the area the opposing team are to be awarded a penalty. Likewise, if a defender enters his/her own goal area, penalty will be awarded. **If a forward for the opposing team enters the goal area, a free kick on the centre spot (halfway) will be awarded.**
2. Goalkeepers may only return the ball to play with an underarm throw which must be chest height and within his/her own half of the pitch. If the goalkeeper returns the ball into play by kicking the ball (referee's discretion), a corner will be awarded against the goalkeeper.
3. All throw-ins are underarm.
4. **Kick Off and all centre kicks (restarting after a goal) are to be started with a drop ball by the referee.**
4. Corners are to be thrown in underarm.
5. One step rule for penalty kicks.
6. Substitutions can be made in the normal way at any time, but the ball must be dead at the time, ie out for a throw-in / corner, free kick, etc. The referee must be informed before the change can be made.
7. No offside rule.



COMPETITION

1. All group games will be 10 (ten) minutes one way.
2. All Under 8 games will be played as friendly, non-competitive games and all participants will be awarded a medal at the end of the tournament.
3. Semi-finals and finals times are as per tournament programme. If a draw at the end of the match, the teams change ends and toss a coin for kick off and play for the golden goal. Once the golden goal has been scored the game is at an end.
4. Group games:
 - 4 points for a win
 - 2 points for a score draw
 - 1 point for no score draw
 - 0 points for a defeat
5. All players sent from the field of play will take **NO** part in the Tournament. **ALL** cases of misconduct, however, minor, will be reported to the appropriate County FA Secretary within 48 hours.
6. In group games, if teams are level on points when the group is concluded, the placings will be decided goal difference then goals scored will decide placings. If still level, then the result between the two teams will count. If still level, then sudden death penalties are to be taken, with the winner going through.

LATE ARRIVALS, ARRIVALS & REGISTRATION FOR SATURDAY & SUNDAY

No refund of entry fee will be made to teams who do not attend or arrive after 9.15 am for the morning Tournament and 2.15 pm for the afternoon Tournament registration time. The entry of teams arriving late will be at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

For Saturday & Sunday

Teams' registration time will be 8.45 am to 9.15 am - morning games

Teams' registration time will be 1.45 pm to 2.15 pm – afternoon games

SUNDRIES

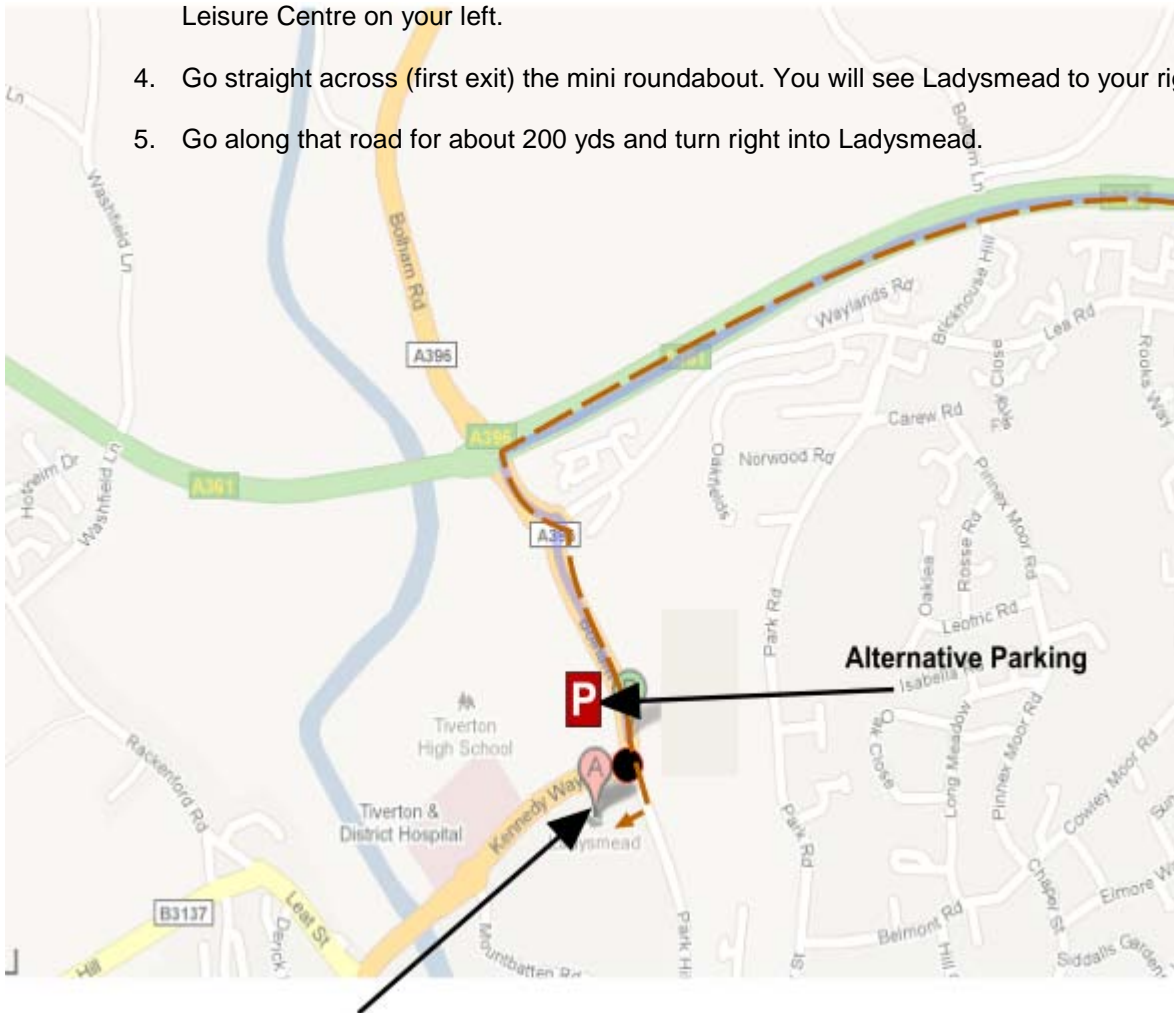
1. All efforts will be made to adhere to the programme. Unforeseen circumstances such as teams not arriving, etc will affect this principle.
2. During games the Referee's decision is final. **DO NOT ABUSE THE REFEREES.**
3. In any other matters, the decision of the Organising Committee will be final.
4. Each team is required to bring a match ball for use in their games. A size **4** ball is required for use by **ALL** age groups.
5. In a clash of colours, the home team on the fixture (first mentioned) will be required to change kit.
6. Only players and coaches are allowed on the pitch. Please do not climb over the wall - use the gates around the main pitch.
7. For health and safety reasons, please ensure you inform all players, coaching staff, family and supporters, they are **NOT** to sit on any of the walls surrounding the pitch



DIRECTIONS

Coming off the Motorway

1. Exit at Junction 27 on the M5
2. Head towards Tiverton on the A361 dual carriageway travelling for about seven miles. Ignore the first junction for A396 Tiverton and Bickleigh (Gornhay Cross) and keep going **(this is important)** a little further until you reach a large roundabout.
3. Turn left (see map below) at the roundabout take first exit (A3126) for the Town Centre and Castle, continue along that road for about 400 yds crossing a new roundabout, passing a college on your right, and our youth sections field on the left and Tiverton Rugby Club on right until you meet a mini roundabout. You will notice the Exe Valley Leisure Centre on your left.
4. Go straight across (first exit) the mini roundabout. You will see Ladysmead to your right
5. Go along that road for about 200 yds and turn right into Ladysmead.

PARKING

One the weekend of the tournament there will **NO parking** at Ladysmead on a first come first served basis. If you are not able to park in Ladysmead we have alternative parking at The Petroc College opposite the football pitches you will have passed at stage 3 of the directions above. Please be aware **there will be a small fee for parking on the day (£1 per car).**
